

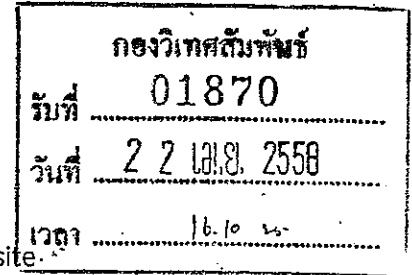
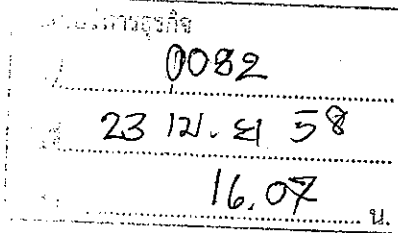

As you are aware, an USCO summer program "Summer Course at Niigata University: Lessons from Contemporary Japan", 17-28 August, is now open for application.

Consisting of two 2-credit classes, "Environmental Problems and Development of Policies in Japan" and "Japanese Experiences from Various Perspectives" (coping with natural disasters, business management, international development cooperation, and international relations), the program provides not only lectures in class rooms but also visits and meetings to see the reality of the "Lessons from Contemporary Japan". I believe that that design of the program helps students understand Japan's lessons clearly. It is also a good opportunity to make friends. Actually many of the students of the past three years say that they learned and enjoyed a lot.
